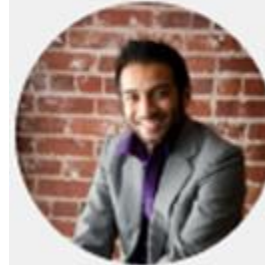

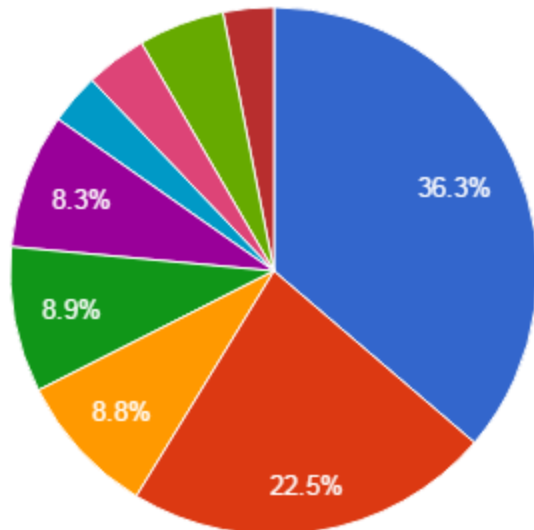

# HCOMP 2016: Papers

- **Full papers:** 27 (30.2% *acceptance rate*)
  - Record # of submissions, >25% increase from 2015
  - Journal tie-in: JAIR Award-Winning Papers Track
  - Drafted & Posted Review Guidelines Early
  - 2-level PC Structure, Abstract submission + bidding, Resp/Disc.
  - 10 page submissions (AAAI maximum)
- **Works-in-Progress & Demonstration Papers**
  - 25 *Works-in-Progress*, 6 *Demonstrations*
  - Non-archival / no AAAI digital library this year; arXiv optional
  - *Many fewer than 2015; did we break something?*



# New Encore Track

- **HCOMP is an interdisciplinary field**
  - Some authors publish primarily in journals
  - Some publish in topical conferences (e.g., NLP)
- **Encore Track invites encore presentations**
  - 3 invited talks on other conference award papers
  - 8 additional Encore papers presented as posters
- *Should we continue?*

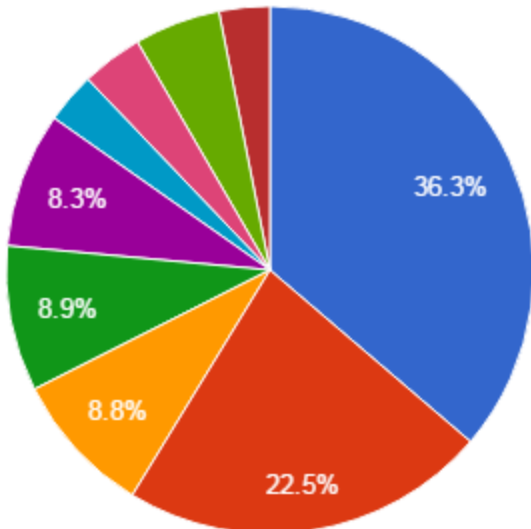
- #1 Challenge: late start securing venue
- 1<sup>st</sup> year of 3-Day Technical Program
  - HCOMP 2017 will return to 2-Day Technical Program
- More workshops: 1 tutorial, 3 workshops
  - No open call this year; would be good in 2016
  - Should DC be separate day before workshops?
- 1<sup>st</sup> Industry Track; mixed success
  - Should we continue to have an open call?
